

MEETING MINUTES

Village of Exeland
Regular Monthly Meeting
October 13, 2025 at 6:00 pm

CALL TO ORDER: The regular monthly meeting of the Exeland Village Board was called to order by Nicole Trott at 6:00 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

ROLL CALL: Present: Duane Mansky, Nicole Trott, Deb Fetting, Robert Deach. Susan Kopras appeared by phone.

AGENDA PROPERLY POSTED: Trott certified the agenda was properly posted.

APPROVE AGENDA: A motion was made by Mansky to approve the agenda. Trott seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: A motion was made by Trott to approve minutes from September 8, 2025. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT: Fetting gave Treasurer's report. A motion was made by Mansky to approve the Treasurer's report as written. Trott seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None.

POSSIBLE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSE:

Fetting reported getting a notice from an alcohol distributor of a delinquent balance due for an establishment with a Class B liquor license in the Village of Exeland. After discussion, Trott made the motion to consult with the Wisconsin Towns Association legal department and follow appropriate steps as advised. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

VOTING MACHINE OFFER FROM COMMAND CENTRAL:

Fetting reported getting an agreement from Command Central for a free upgraded voting machine with a minimal delivery cost. Trott made the motion to sign the agreement with Command Central upgrading the ICX voting machine to an ICE voting machine with the only cost being a minimal delivery fee. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PSC WATER RATE INCREASE UPDATE:

Fetting reported the simplified application with the PSC was submitted on October 1, 2025 and she received notification that the application was approved for a 3% rate increase. The effective date will be January 1, 2026.

BUDGET 2026 MEETING—OCT 17TH REMINDER:

Trott reminded board members the budget meeting is on October 17, 2025 at 3:00 p.m.

WATER AND SEWER:

Deach reported the fiber optic lines are being installed in the Village; therefore, he will have several locates in the next few weeks. He also reported that a water leak on Elm Park Drive was causing our water usage to almost double and is now seeing the lowest usage rates he has seen in a long time.

ROADS & PARKS:

Deach reported winterization of the bathrooms will be completed soon due to the upcoming cold weather.

APPROVE EXPENDITURES FOR PAYMENT: Mansky made the motion to approve expenditures for payment. Motion was seconded by Trott. Motion carried.

SET NEXT MEETING DATE: The next meeting date is set for November 10, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.

ADJOURNMENT: Mansky made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Trott. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 pm.
