

MEETING MINUTES

Village of Exeland
Regular Monthly Meeting
June 8, 2026 at 6:00 pm

CALL TO ORDER: The regular monthly meeting of the Exeland Village Board was called to order by Susan Kopras at 6:00 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

ROLL CALL: Present: Susan Kopras, Duane Mansky, Nicole Trott, Deb Fetting, Robert Deach.

AGENDA PROPERLY POSTED: Kopras certified the agenda was properly posted.

APPROVE AGENDA: A motion was made by Trott to approve the agenda. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: A motion was made by Mansky to approve the minutes from May 11, 2026. Kopras seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT: Fetting gave Treasurer's report. Discussion was held regarding Sawyer County no longer acting as a provider for election services. The Clerk-Treasurer will be required to attend approximately 12 hours of on-line training for the Village to become a self-provider. A motion was made by Trott to approve the Treasurer's report as written. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None.

EMERGENCY LIGHTING FOR VILLAGE HALL:

Discussion was held on the need for emergency lighting in the event the power goes out while the Hall is being used, especially during an election. Mansky made the motion to approve Deach ordering emergency lighting for no more than \$100. Trott seconded the motion. Motion carried.

WAGES FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS:

After discussion, Trott made the motion that the Village has the option to allow for alternate wages for projects not included in an employee job description. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

MOU WITH SAWYER COUNTY:

Board members reviewed and discussed the MOU with the Sawyer County Clerk regarding elections. Mansky made the motion to accept and sign the MOU as written. Trott seconded the motion. Motion carried.

REVIEW/APPROVE LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS:

Board member reviewed and discussed approval of liquor license applications from The Frontier Saloon and Grill, Olsen's Buckhorn Bar, SANFAN Enterprises, LLC (The Depot), and Potter's Café, LLC and a tobacco application from SANFAN Enterprises, LLC (The Depot). Trott made the motion to approve all applications and grant liquor and tobacco licenses. Mansky seconded the motion. Motion carried.

WATER AND SEWER:

Deach reported PFAS is completed with no detections. He has scheduled 3 water meter replacement and possibly more upcoming. eCMAR has been submitted and we got all A's. The new electrical and pump has been installed in the well house. One sewer pump had to be replaced because it failed. Koprass reported she spoke with BevComm regarding hooking up the high-speed internet at the hall and well house. The new charge at the Hall is \$59.95 per month and the well house remains the same. Arrangements were made for Deach to open the facilities for the installations.

ROADS & PARKS:

Deach reported he will order parts for the ballpark bathroom roof.

APPROVE EXPENDITURES FOR PAYMENT: Mansky made the motion to approve expenditures for payment. Motion was seconded by Trott. Motion carried.

SET NEXT MEETING DATE: The next meeting date is set for July 13, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.

ADJOURNMENT: Mansky made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Trott. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:34 pm.
